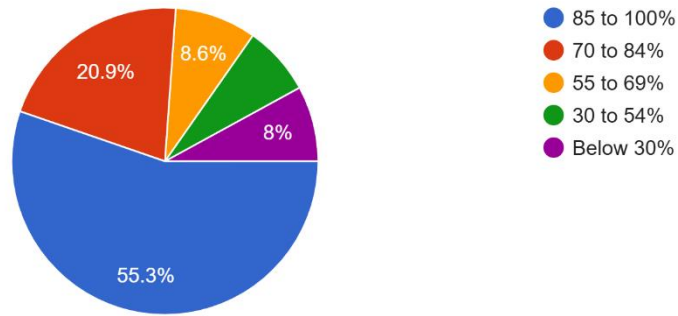

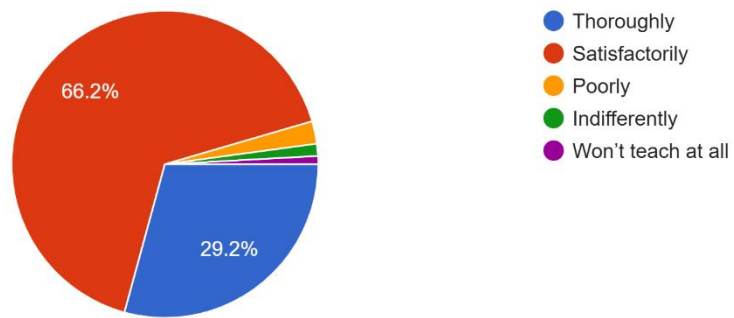
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

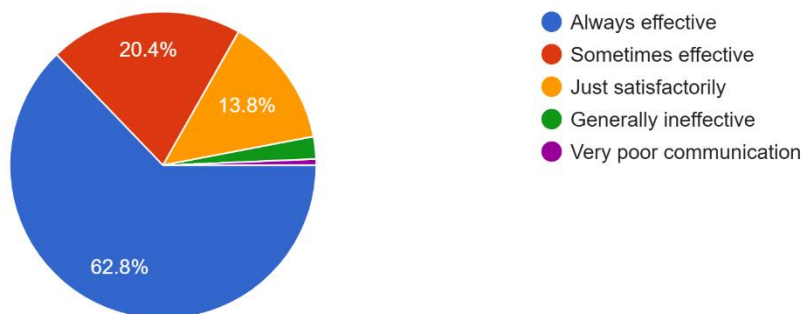
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

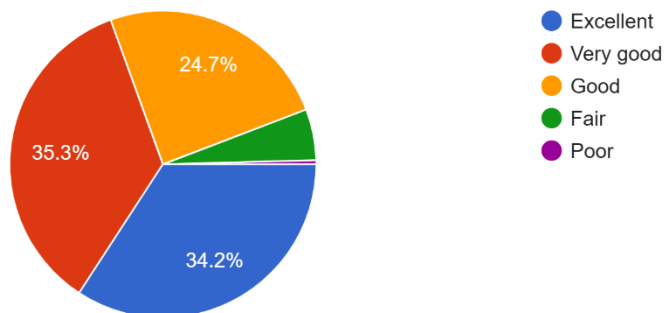
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

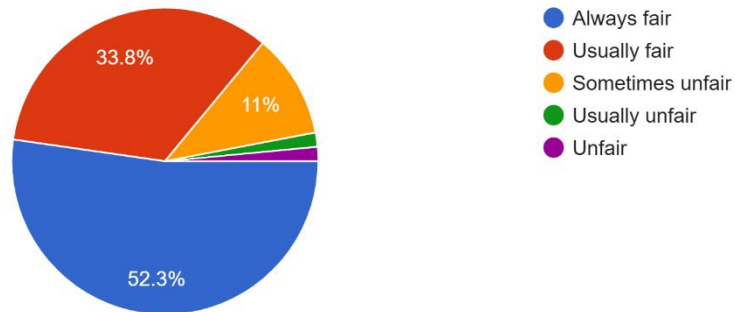
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

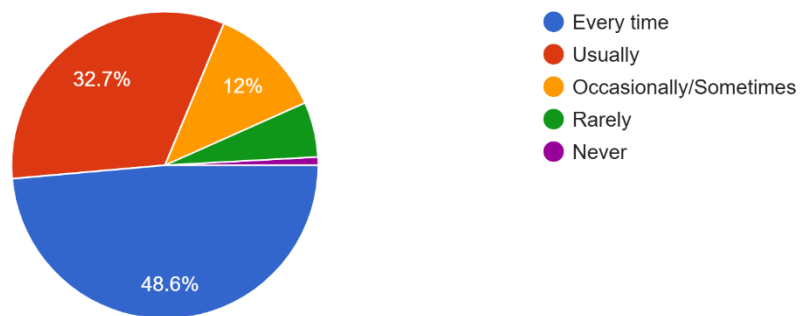
Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

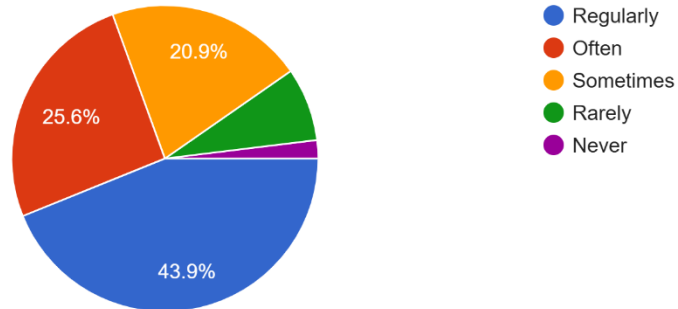
Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

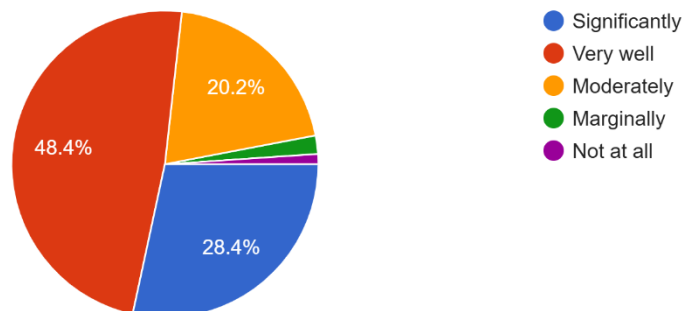

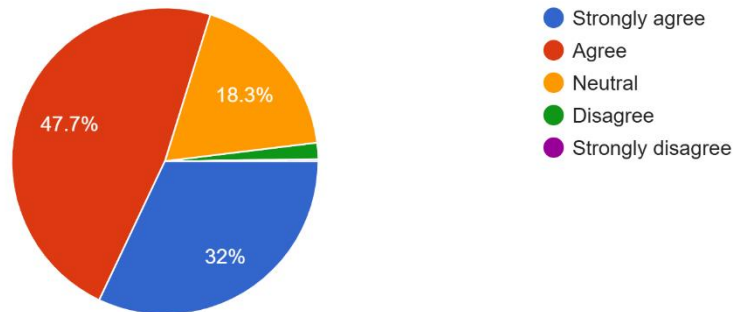
The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

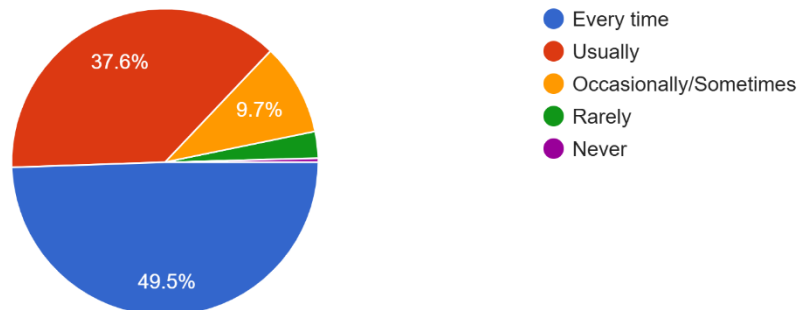

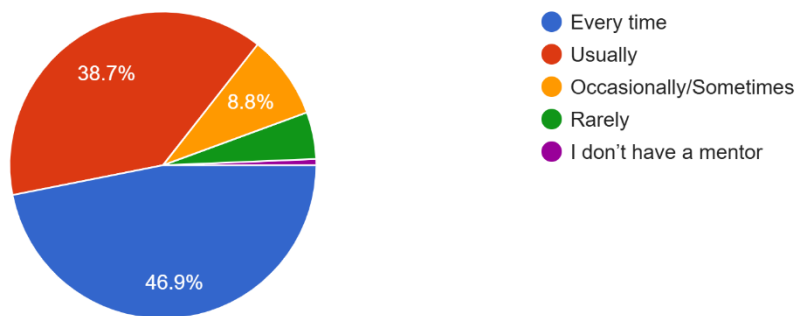
Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

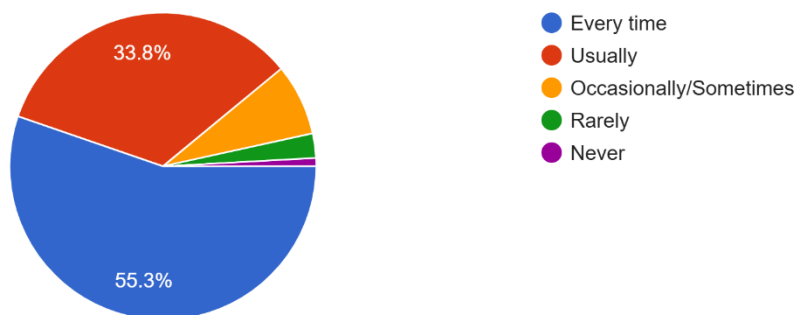

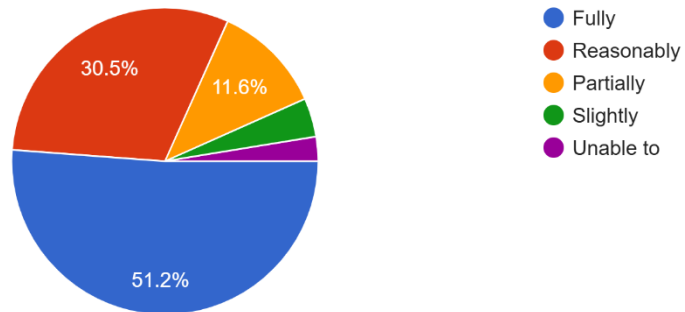

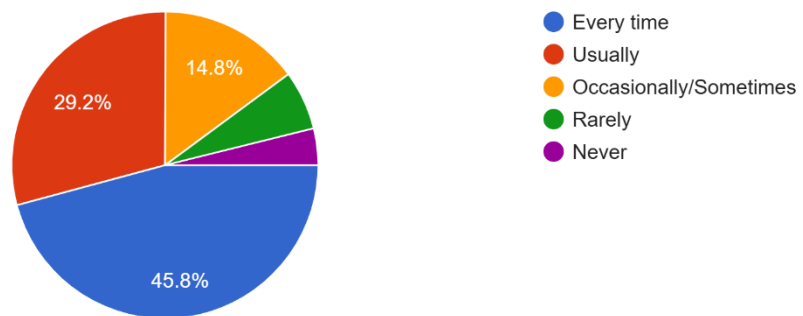

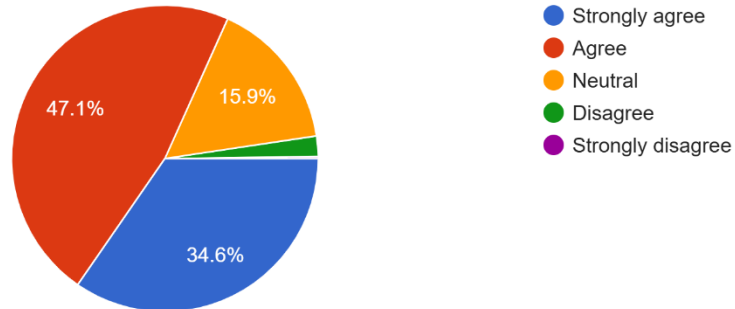

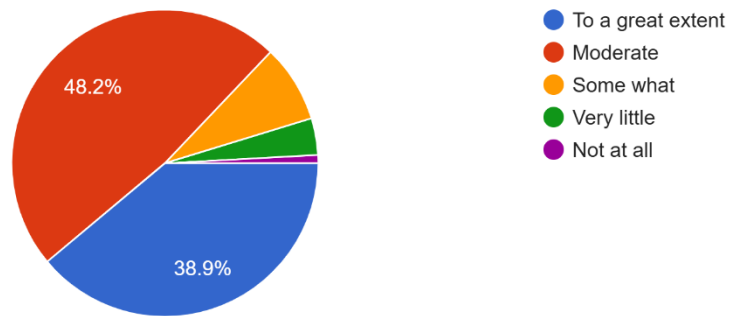

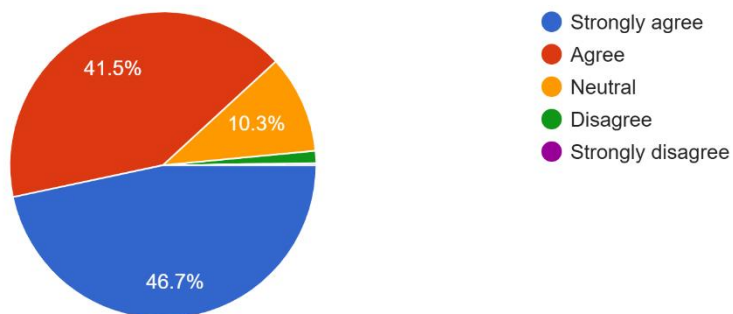

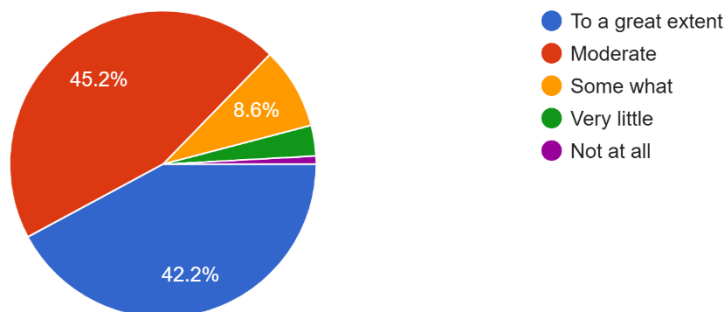

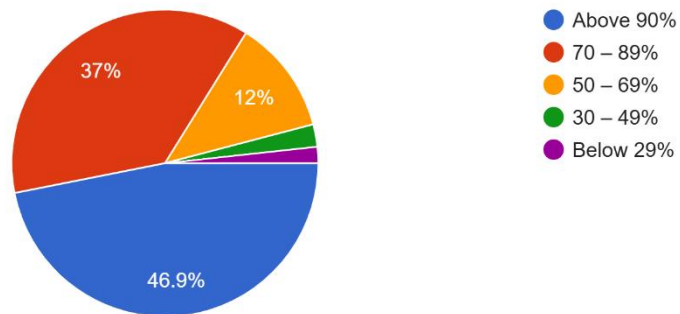

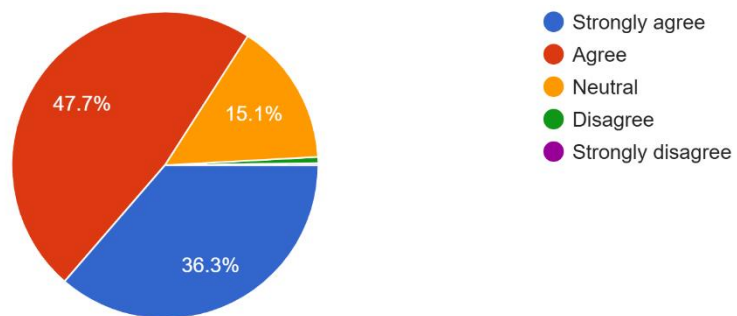
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

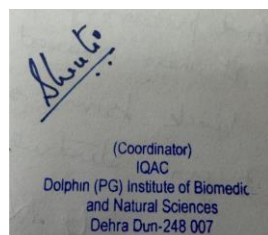
Summary of the Suggestions given by the students

S. No.	Suggestions given by students
1.	The mentorship system should be strengthened so that students receive better academic, personal and career guidance.
2.	Students suggested that college dress may be relaxed on Saturdays.
3.	Greater focus should be given to skill development, innovation and practical exposure.
4.	One day in a week may be earmarked for extracurricular and co-curricular activities.
5.	Industry-academia collaboration should be strengthened through guest lectures, internships, industrial visits and real-world projects integrated into the curriculum.
6.	Regular career counselling sessions should be organized for students.
7.	Emotional well-being and mental health support should be ensured for every student.
8.	Teachers should place greater emphasis on practical knowledge and application-based teaching.
9.	Regular personality development sessions should be conducted for students.
10.	Co-curricular and extracurricular activities should be organized more regularly.
11.	Classroom interaction between teachers and students should be improved to make teaching-learning more engaging.
12.	Industrial visits, field trips and educational tours should be conducted more frequently.
13.	Subject teachers should provide question banks to help students prepare better for examinations.
14.	Water coolers should be installed in every block for student convenience.
15.	More hands-on activities, simulations and real-life applications should be incorporated to connect theory with practice and improve problem-solving skills.
16.	Internship and placement opportunities for students should be enhanced.
17.	The medium of instruction should be predominantly English.
18.	Utilization of technology and visual aids to make lessons more dynamic, engaging and accessible.

Action Taken Report

S. No.	Suggestion Given by Students	Action Taken / Proposed by the Institute
1	Strengthen mentorship	The mentoring system has been reinforced by directing mentors to hold regular interactions with mentees for academic guidance, attendance monitoring, personal support and career counselling. Departments have been advised to maintain mentoring records more systematically.
2	No college uniform on Saturdays	The suggestion was considered positively. Students have been permitted to attend college in decent casual wear on Saturdays, subject to the prescribed dress code and discipline norms issued by the institution.
3	Focus on skill development and innovation	Greater emphasis has been placed on skill enhancement, innovation-oriented activities, workshops, practical sessions and student participation in project-based and creative learning activities. Departments have been encouraged to organize skill-based sessions on a regular basis.
4	One day in a week for extracurricular activities	The institution has taken steps to encourage greater participation in extracurricular and co-curricular activities by planning such activities in a more structured manner. Second half of all Saturdays have been designated for club activities to ensure regular student engagement without affecting academic schedules.
5	Strengthen industry-academia collaboration through guest lectures, internships, industrial visits and real-world projects	Departments and the Training & Placement Cell have been encouraged to organize more guest lectures by experts, industrial visits, internship opportunities and activity-based learning linked to real-world exposure. Such collaborations are being promoted more actively.
6	Regular career counselling sessions should be held	Career counselling and guidance sessions are being organized through departments, mentors and the Training & Placement Cell so that students receive guidance regarding higher education, employment and competitive opportunities.
7	Ensure emotional and well-being support to each and every student	The institution continues to support student well-being through counselling support, mentor interaction and sensitization initiatives. Students are encouraged to approach mentors, faculty members and the designated support system (the counsellor) whenever needed.
8	Teachers need to focus on providing practical knowledge	Faculty members have been advised to adopt more application-based teaching methods and to strengthen the practical orientation of classroom instruction through examples, demonstrations, case discussions, field exposure and hands-on learning wherever possible.

9	Regular personality development sessions for students	The institution has initiated / encouraged sessions on communication skills, confidence building, interview readiness, soft skills and personality development through departmental activities and the Training & Placement Cell.
10	Regular co-curricular and extracurricular activities should be organized	Departments and student activity units have been advised to organize co-curricular and extracurricular activities more regularly for holistic student development.
11	Interaction between teachers and students should improve in the classroom	Faculty members have been encouraged to make classrooms more participative and interactive through discussion-based teaching, questioning, feedback, presentations and student involvement in the learning process.
12	Industrial visits, field trips and educational trips should be conducted frequently	Departments have been encouraged to incorporate more field visits, industrial visits and educational tours as part of the academic process, subject to feasibility, academic relevance and approval.
13	Students need question bank from subject faculty	Faculty members have been advised to provide better academic support material, including question banks, important topics, practice questions and model guidance wherever appropriate.
14	Water cooler should be installed in every block	The suggestion has been forwarded to the administration for infrastructure planning and phased improvement of drinking water facilities in student areas.
15	Hands-on activities, simulations and real-world applications should be incorporated	Faculty members have been encouraged to increase the use of hands-on activities, simulations, demonstrations, practical assignments and real-life examples to make teaching-learning more effective and outcome-oriented.
16	Internship / placement opportunities need to be enhanced	The Training & Placement Cell has been directed to make continued efforts to expand internship and placement opportunities by strengthening institutional linkages and employer outreach.
17	Medium of instruction should be mostly English	Faculty members have been advised to increasingly use English as the medium of instruction while also ensuring clarity and inclusiveness for students from diverse backgrounds. Efforts are being made to improve students' comfort with academic English.
